## **Adapted from Matthew 14:22-33**

### **Jesus Walks on the Water**

#### **Characters: Jesus, Peter, Disciples and Narrator**

**Narrator:** Then Jesus made his followers get into the boat. He told them to go ahead of him to the other side of the lake. Jesus stayed there to tell the people they could go home.

**Narrator:** After he said good-bye to them, he went alone up into the hills to pray. It was late, and Jesus was there alone.

**Narrator:** By this time, the boat was already far away on the lake. The boat was having trouble because of the waves, and the wind was blowing against it.

**Narrator:** Between three and six o'clock in the morning, Jesus' followers were still in the boat. Jesus came to them. He was walking on the water. When the followers saw him walking on the water, they were afraid.

**Disciples:** "It's a ghost!"

**Jesus:** "Have courage! It is I! Don't be afraid."

**Peter:** "Lord, if that is really you, then tell me to come to you on the water."

**Jesus:** "Come."

**Narrator:** And Peter left the boat and walked on the water to Jesus. But when Peter saw the wind and the waves, he became afraid and began to sink.

**Peter:** "Lord, save me!"

**Narrator:** Then Jesus reached out his hand and caught Peter.

**Jesus:** "Your faith is small. Why did you doubt?"

**Narrator:** After Peter and Jesus were in the boat, the wind became calm. Then those who were in the boat worshiped Jesus

**Disciples:** "Truly you are the Son of God!"
