GRIEF SHARE

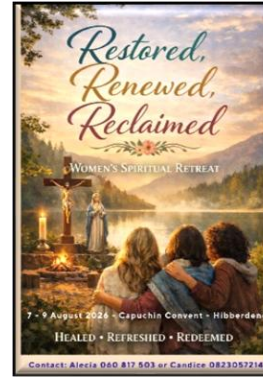
