HOLY HOUR AND FORMATION

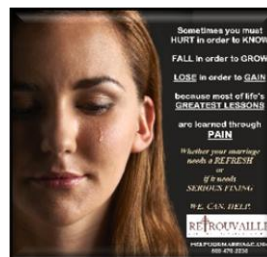
